



To help new families moving into Broad Bay a “Newcomer Assistance Service” is offered.

The focus of our Newcomer Assistance Service is on families with at least one preschool/ primary (5-12 years) child who would like to settle in Broad Bay. One parent needs to have residency or a work visa. This free service is run by a small group of volunteers whose children attend Broad Bay School on the Otago Peninsula.

As part of our service we:

- ✓ Give the new arrivals a warm welcome
- ✓ Help them to find accommodation locally
- ✓ Arrange a school visit, including an opportunity for children to "try out" our local school
- ✓ Present them with a Welcome Pack once they've decided to settle here
- ✓ Introduce them to others in the community
- ✓ Keep in contact with them especially the woman (so that she gets connected with others)
- ✓ Whatever their particular needs, we will endeavour to assist.
- ✓ We are happy to help in any way we can.
